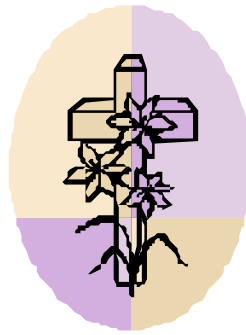

Our Services

Community Referrals

GTA Support Group serves as a liaison between our clients and local social and community service agencies. We assist each client in finding the best agency to satisfy their need.

Funeral/Memorial Service Planning

GTA Support Group refers clients to our program sponsors that provide funeral services at minimum cost as a community service. GTA Support Group designs and prints memorial service programs and provides a register book free of charge. We also provide assistance with miscellaneous fees such as, the cost to have the obituary in the paper, burial permit, escort to cemetery, etc., as funds are available.

In addition to our pregnancy and infant loss support group, we also provide grief support via our website.
